



BOOKING procedures



Accessibility

Before making any reservations, make sure you have the necessary skills for this kind of trip, and that you are in the right season:

- The best snow conditions are found between **mid-January and mid-March**;
- For **intermediate** and **advanced skiers**;
- To assess your skiing ability, the Morin-Heights sector offers a training circuit. Contact **Chalet Bellevue** for more information!

Be aware that weather conditions before and during your stay may affect your group's progress. Here's a list of things to check before you leave:

- **Ice thickness on lakes**
- **Rain or freezing rain**
- **Heavy snowfall or accumulation**



It is always possible to ski via “Le P'tit Train du Nord” if conditions do not permit on the nordic trails

Equipment

You must have **nordic touring skis**, also known as **back-country cross-country skis**. The trails and tracks you'll be using are **NOT mechanically groomed**. You'll need specialized off-piste cross-country skis (scales or waxed), boots with sturdy bindings and skins (half- or full-length).

If you need to rent: Reserve your rental equipment as soon as you have booked your accommodation!

Say you'll be arriving on ski as part of the White Routes.

Access fees

Access to certain trails requires a daily fee per person. Here's how to obtain them:

- **Day 1:** Passage through Val-David / Val-Morin Regional Park: **Val-David-Val-Morin access fees**
- **Day 3:** Passage through the alpine hiking trail at Mont-Olympia ski resort. An acceptance of risk must be signed on site: **Mont-Olympia ticket**
